



NOTE FROM AUTHOR

Five Karen refugees showed up in our church one Sunday and asked to speak with me after the service. They sat in my office and told me there were seventy more of them that wanted to join our church. Then they began to tell me how deep their needs were.

This really frightened me. While our spiritual life was growing stronger, our finances were not keeping pace. I sat in the face of their need thinking, *Come on, we've got our own problems*. We thought we were going to be selling the church and moving to a storefront. We were broke. How were we going to begin helping a people with such deep, deep need?

But I was also thinking about our intention to put Christ at the center of our common life. Having placed ourselves under his banner, I began to glimpse how inconvenient a proposition that could be. I was finding myself having to beware lest I unsay with my life what I was professing with my lips. I was having to confront his words "Love your neighbor." I had to obey "Feed my sheep." I had to face "Whenever you do it to the least of these, you do it to me." In the midst of my own anxiety and fear and reluctance, and believing that no one would blame me if I let this one pass by, I found myself saying to Ye Win, "I don't know how this is going to work out. I don't know how we're going to be of any help to you, but you come to church. You join us, and we'll all figure it out together."


Too many of us stand in the shadows, peeking through the side curtains of the stage, watching as monumental God stories unfold somewhere out there under the lights. Stories we ache to join. Stories that have the potential to spark faith and kindle hope. Stories that, on our most graced and alert days, we suspect we were made for.

But something blocks our way. Something that worms down into the stuff we are made of and plants a potent lie. It whispers that it's far better to remain safely invisible than dare to be seen. It says that it doesn't really matter what you do, because anyone else will do in a pinch. It murmurs that a truly humble Christian woman would demur, hold the curtain open for someone else. Nothing is better for us or the people we love than showing up to the great drama to which God has invited us. Nothing is better than going where he goes. Daring where he dares. Taking the stage when he says, "This is it, kid. See that light pooling out there? Go find it. For this moment and this time, the stage is yours."

"So what about you?"


This is the scariest question in all the universe to me. The one that makes me duck and weave like an amateur boxer in the answering. I will give you my attention all the livelong day and hardly whisper of my own life.

I thought I might like to write a book in this way. I had the title picked out and the topic selected. Yet every time I sat down to sensibly, safely write, I couldn't bring forth a word. Finally, in frustration one day, while sitting in this very chair, I began to simply type what was actually pulsing in my heart and ringing in my ears. I wrote about fear and brokenness. I talked about savoring life like the strange, sugary center of white honeysuckle. Fighting the doubts that sometimes wore black ski masks when they rattled my doorknobs late at night. I told the truth about some things I'd rather keep hidden under the couch cushions with the dirty pennies. I admitted to both struggles and victories. I didn't make so many statements. I told more stories.

When I stepped into this book, I crossed a line. I found myself in a new place of living more fully, loving more bravely, and showing up as I really am in ways I hadn't quite dared before. This, I discovered, is the vast and wild and beautiful territory of the fiercehearted.

It is who we are, who we've been all along. Where we belong.

Instead of trying to turn our selfishness off, what if we focused on turning it toward its proper object? This, of course, is what we've finally figured out how to do when it comes to our sex drives. When we celebrate human sexuality and encourage its full expression within marriage, two good things happen at the same time. First, marriages are re-energized. Sex is an engine for marriage. It makes marriage "go." Second, the temptations toward any harmful, sinful expressions of our sexuality are greatly reduced, because we no longer have an excess of suppressed sexual energy.

It works the same way with selfishness. Just as sex is an engine for marriage, selfishness is an engine for the spiritual life-a source of tremendous power and energy. And if we tap into it within its legitimate sphere, two good things happen at the same time. First, our relationship with God is re-energized, as we selfishly seek the higher and deeper satisfactions that only he can provide. Just as a husband's sex drive draws him toward his wife, our selfishness drive can draw us toward God. Second, because our selfishness now has an outlet, we no longer have an excess of suppressed selfish energy. This means we won't be as tempted by cheap, short-term substitutes—not because we've stopped being selfish but because we've learned to direct our selfishness toward a higher goal.

By redirecting our selfishness, we redeem it.

elfish. It's a word that has zero positive connotations, especially among people of faith. Christians are supposed to be other-focused, even to the point of neglecting themselves in the process . . . right?

One of the things that baffles me is how impotent the Church has become in the face of rampant evil. We have lost our fight.


